



## Mombo Camp

### Overview

The dining room, bar area and living area overlook the open plain in front of the camp and there is a plunge pool for relaxing in the heat of the day. Activities at Mombo include morning and afternoon game drives in open 4 x 4 Land Rovers. The game viewing in the area is excellent, and guests could have the opportunity to see Lion, Leopard, large herds of Buffalo, Cheetah, Wild Dog, Elephant, Hyena, Giraffe, Wildebeest and Zebra. Access into this area is only by aircraft.

### Room Information

All rooms are superbly furnished, luxurious tents, raised off the ground. The guest's rooms and the walkways that connect the rooms to the living area are up to 2m off the ground, allowing game to wander freely through the camp – but at the same time allowing for guest's safety. The canvas rooms are extremely spacious and well appointed and have en-suit facilities under canvas and an additional outdoor shower for those who enjoy a shower under the stars.

### Policies

#### Cancellation Policy

##### Groups

150-90 days inclusive - 20% of the space booked can be released with no penalty. Any additional space released will be subject to a 45% cancellation fee on the full cost of the safari (ie accommodation, transfers, charters etc).

89-31 days inclusive - 0% of the space booked can be released with no penalty. Any additional space released will be subject to a 60% cancellation fee on the full cost of the safari (i.e. accommodation, transfers, charters etc).

0-30 days inclusive - 100% cancellation fee.

## FIT

If prior to 8 weeks before departure your deposit is forfeited. If your cancellation is made after the due date for full payment of your tour fare, charges will be levied. The scale of charges, expressed as a percentage of the tour prices, is as follows:

Less than 8 weeks notice - Deposit plus 25 %
