



Savuti Camp

Overview

Savuti Camp is situated in the Linyanti Reserve along the Savuti Channel in northern Botswana. The camp is built about 17 kilometres 'downstream' from the source of the Savuti. The channel stopped flowing in 1980 and what was a Hippo-filled river, is now wide, open grasslands.

Room Information

Savuti Camp is a comfortable camp providing accommodation in 7 walk-in tented rooms with en-suite facilities. Each room is raised off the ground on wooden decks.

Policies

Cancellation Policy

Groups

150-90 days inclusive - 20% of the space booked can be released with no penalty. Any additional space released will be subject to a 45% cancellation fee on the full cost of the safari (ie accommodation, transfers, charters etc).

89-31 days inclusive - 0% of the space booked can be released with no penalty. Any additional space released will be subject to a 60% cancellation fee on the full cost of the safari (i.e. accommodation, transfers, charters etc).

0-30 days inclusive - 100% cancellation fee.

FIT

If prior to 8 weeks before departure your deposit is forfeited. If your cancellation is made after the due date for full payment of your tour fare, charges will be levied. The scale of charges, expressed as a percentage of the tour prices, is as follows:

For a quarter of a century, the Channel was dry, creating wide-open grassland, home to both quantities and varieties of wildlife and a legendary predator's enclave.
