Overview

Botswana's magnificent Okavango Delta is a maze of lagoons, lakes and hidden channels covering an area of over 16,000 km² in flood and shrinking to less than 9,000 km² in the dry season. Combine Camp Okavango situated in the Delta with Camp Moremi situated in the Moremi Game Reserve. An unforgettable experience awaits.

Itinerary

Day 1 Arrival in Botswana

Upon arrival at Maun Airport and after clearing customs/immigrations, you will be met and assisted onto your scheduled charter flight into the Okavango Delta. This scenic flight lasts about 30 minutes to the Xaxanaka region of Moremi Game Reserve. Upon arrival there, you will be met by your guide and transferred the short distance to Camp Moremi. Overnight at Camp Moremi on a fully inclusive basis.

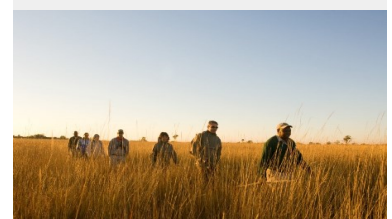
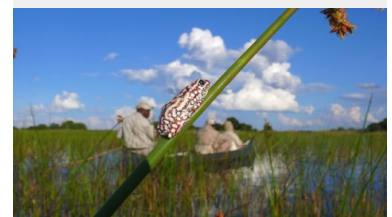
