The lodge is a meeting place where friends old and new gather to share memories against a background of memorabilia and artefacts gathered from all over the African continent. Tales from the bush are absorbed and then shared over a boma dinner under the stars that evening. New friends are made and experiences gathered here are treasured for a lifetime.
